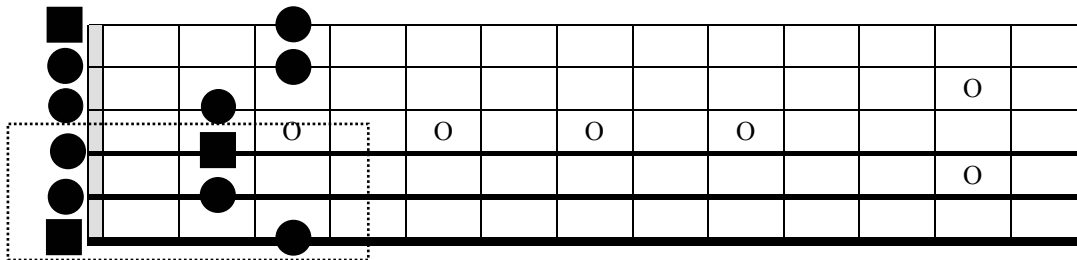
## Open Fingerings

■ - TONIC NOTE – Gives the key name, strongest note of the scale.

□ - MAIN NOTES - Most riffs use only the low notes of a scale.

### E Minor Pentatonic Scale.

this fingering belongs to the open E chord.

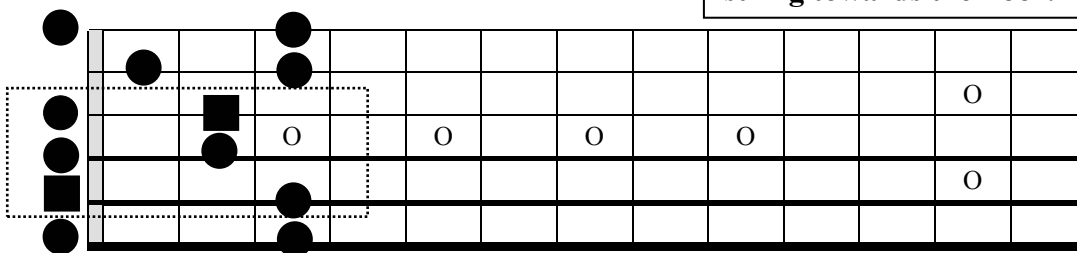

Notice that the main notes are in the same shape or pattern as they were for the E shape. This time though the pattern is moved one string towards the floor.
